Husky Marching Alliance (HMA)

The HMA is our award-winning Marching Band, which includes winds, percussion, and colorguard. We perform at football games, parades, field shows, special events, pep rallies, assemblies, and other events throughout the year. Our primary competition season runs September to December. The HMA is a 7-time State Band Championship finalist, most recently finishing 4th in Division 5A in 2018. We have won numerous Sweepstakes and First Place awards and have marched at Disneyland and the Hollywood Christmas Parade!

Band Camp

This year's "camp" runs July 26-30 and August 2-4, with our Welcome Back Barbecue on Friday, August 6th. The purpose of camp is to work everyone into shape, both physically and musically, for the upcoming season. Each day is split into two parts, marching in the morning and playing music in the afternoon. Rehearsals will be run by our experience staff, assisted by our Drum Majors. Here is your checklist for band camp:

- Get plenty of sleep the night before – especially the first day!
- Dress in PE-type clothes – t-shirts, shorts, athletic shoes, hats, sunglasses
- Bring your own chilled water in a one-gallon jug (school colors please)
- Bring your own lunch or have it delivered by a parent (no Door Dash, etc.)
- Yes, we have a microwave if you need to heat food.
- Make sure your instrument is in good working condition
 - Woodwinds make sure you have 3 good reeds at all times.
 - (We have reeds for bari sax and bass clarinet)
- All members will arrive at the "band gate" on the north side of the building.
 - Visitors are not allowed to enter campus at this time
- Students are not allowed to leave campus during camp hours unless staff is notified by a parent of a scheduled appointment or other important occasion.
